### **EUNRO Region Report Guidelines**

Our papers are designed to be as accessible to as large an audience as possible. They are primarily informative but may also be theoretical and conceptual. They have a practical application and clear recommendations (key points) for policymakers and academics.

#### **Region Reports should include the following:**

- A policy relevance statement: 1 sentence on the practical or theoretical utility of the paper
- 5 keywords
- An abstract (50-60 words) in English and language of relevant region/author's native language
- 3 key points (each around 2 sentences/40 words long)
- Main text (2,000 - 2,500 words)

#### **For references:**

- In text as a number
- APA style in references

#### **Example:**

Smith, T. (2020). The citation manual for students: A quick guide (2nd ed.). Wiley. 235-245.

#### **For the graphical abstract (recommended):**

An image, table of data, graph, chart or figure that visualises the main point(s) of the paper.
